The Recipe Box...Chocolate Hazelnut Mug Cakes for Two

One of my radio guests from Canada shared this wonderful recipe and I thought it was perfect for Valentine's Day, actually any day would do, and it only has 3 ingredients. Charmian Christie is a wonderful cook and I think once you try this...you'll fix it often. So easy! Enjoy ☺

Ingredients: 1 large egg at room temperature, 2/3 cup chocolate hazelnut spread, 1/4 cup all-purpose flour and 2-12 oz. microwave safe mugs.

Directions: Whisk together in a small bowl the egg and chocolate hazelnut spread until smooth. Divide the batter equally between the mugs. Microwave both mugs on High for 1 minute and 15 seconds. The cakes should begin to pull away from the sides of the mugs and the tops should look dry and spring back

when tapped lightly. If they are not done, continue cooking in 15 second increments. Let cool until set, about 10-15 minutes.

Special tip: For even cooking, pick tall, round mugs with straight sides. Too small a mug might create an overflow of batter. A mug with a tapered bottom might produce mug cakes with gooey bottoms.
