This is a delicious and unique cookie for the holidays and only contains 3 ingredients. One of my guests, Charmian Christie, shared this last year and it is a real winner. Try it...I think you'll like it ©.

Ingredients: ¹/₄ cup roasted pistachios, divided, ¹/₄ cup dried cranberried, divided and 8 ounces white chocolate, chopped.

Directions: You'll need one baking sheet lined with parchment paper. Set aside 12 pistachios and 12 cranberries in separate small bowls for the garnish. Chop the remaining pistachios and cranberries separately. In a medium microwave-safe bowl, heat the white chocolate on High in 15-second intervals, stirring in between. (You can melt the chocolate on the stove, low temperature, stir until smooth.) Once the chocolate is melted and smooth, stir in the chopped pistachios and cranberries. Using a spoon, drop the mixture onto the prepared baking sheet, creating 12 clusters spaced apart. Top each with a reserved pistachio and cranberry. Let cool completely at room temperature. These can be stored up to two weeks.
