The Recipe Box... Double Phocolate Pookies

This is a recipe that I have fixed time and time again and I can guarantee they will disappear quickly. If you love chocolate, these will soon become your favorite and they are so easy to prepare. They make a great gift too.

Ingredients: 5 oz. sweet chocolate-broken into pieces, ½ cup firmly packed dark brown sugar, ½ cup sugar, ½ cup (1 stick) unsalted butter-cut into 4 pieces-room temperature, 1 egg, 2 Tsp. vanilla, 1 cup minus 2 Tbls. unbleached all-purpose flour, ½ Tsp baking soda, pinch of salt, 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips. ½ cup pecan halves or pieces.

Directions: Position rack in center of oven and then preheat to 350 degrees. Combine chocolate and sugars in processor work bowl and chop using 6 on/off turns, then process until chocolate is a fine as sugar, about 1 minute, stopping as necessary to scrape down sides and cover of work bowl. Add butter and blend 30 seconds. Add egg and vanilla and blend 1 minute, stopping as necessary to scrape down sides of work bowl. Add flour, baking soda and salt. Top with chocolate chips and pecans and mix using 2 on/off turns. Run spatula around inside of work bowl to loosen mixture. Blend again using 2 on/off turns. Drop batter by slightly rounded tablespoons onto ungreased baking sheet, spacing 1 ½ inches apart. Bake 10 minutes. Cool 3 minutes on baking sheet. Transfer to racks to cool completely. Makes about 3 dozen. (This recipe came from an old cookbook by Bon Appetit.)
